

# **TEHMI GRANT INSTITUTE OF NURSING EDUCATION** **POST BASIC DIPLOMA IN CRITICAL CARE NURSING**

## **INTRODUCTION**

The Tehmi Grant Institute of Nursing Education invites eligible female candidates to join the 1 year Post Basic Diploma in Critical Care Nursing starting in June 2010. The Institute is a part of Ruby Hall Clinic and is housed in a modern seven-storey building situated at Tadiwala Road, Pune. In addition to the Institute of Nursing education this building also houses the hostel for students and staff nurses of the hospital.

Dr. K. B. Grant established the Ruby Hall Clinic in 1959. From a small beginning as a two bedded nursing home, it has grown over the years into a well-established 550 bedded hospital, which is nationally and internationally acclaimed, for its advanced health care facilities and comprehensive patient care. The Ruby Hall Clinic was converted from a private institution owned by Dr. Grant into a public charitable trust known as the Poona Medical Foundation in 1966, which in 2000, was changed to the present Grant Medical Foundation.

This multi specialty hospital has state of the art facilities in all specialties and has the best clinical field for training doctors for post graduation and is recognized by the National Board of Examination, University of Pune, and the College of Physicians and Surgeons, Mumbai. The hospital is also a fore runner in the field of research activities and provide services at concessional rate to economically backward sections of the society. The hospital is manned by highly trained and dynamic team of medical, nursing and other health care professionals.

The Tehmi Grant Institute of Nursing Education was established in 1999, to train nurses for A grade Certificate Examination in nursing and midwifery conducted by the Maharashtra GNM Examination Board. This facility was upgraded in 2004 into four year graduate program leading to B.Sc nursing degree, affiliated to Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik (MUHS). The students of this Institute will be exposed to the best clinical facilities available and will be trained to become competent nurses for the first level positions in nursing, to provide quality care in hospitals and communities anywhere in the world. We also endeavor to provide all round growth so that they become contributing members of the society.

This college is approved as the Study Centre of PC B, Sc Nursing of Indira Gandhi Open University (IGNOU) from Dec 2006.

## **PHILOSOPHY**

The faculty of Tehmi Grant Institute of Nursing Education believes that they have to conform to the principles of general education. The formal educational preparation provided will be based on these principles and sound professional knowledge and skills. The faculty believes that the registered nurses should be professionally equipped, self directed and socially motivated to effectively deal with day to day problems within existing constraints and act as agents of social change.

Faculty of TGINE believes that registered nurses need to be trained in Critical Care Nursing in clinical settings in order to provide competent care to critically ill patients. Expanding roles of nurses and advances in technology necessitates additional training to prepare them for effective participation in critical care.

## **AIM**

The aim of the Post Basic Critical Care Nursing Program is to prepare registered nurse to assume responsibilities as nurse specialists, consultants, educators and administrators in a wide variety of professional settings.

## OBJECTIVES

On Completion of the 11 months Post Basic Critical Care Nursing Programme, the graduate will be able to –

1. Provide quality care to critically ill patients.
2. Manage & Supervise care of critically ill patients.
3. Teach nurses, allied health professional and family members in areas related to critical care nursing.
4. Conduct research in areas of critical care nursing.

The Institute of Nursing Education is equipped with well ventilated and comfortable class rooms and laboratories. The Institute has a well stocked library with the latest books and periodicals, a computer lab with internet facilities and adequate number of audio-visual aids. We also have a vast variety of reference books and journals in the hospital library.

The clinical teaching of our students is conducted in Ruby Hall Clinic. This hospital is one of the best multi specialty medical Institute in India dedicated to diagnosis, treatment and research in the various aspects of health care. This hospital has state of the art facilities for cardiology, cardiac surgery, neurology, neuro surgery and diagnostic center, transplant units, IVF center, blood bank and cancer center. The hospital has a central laboratory for all investigative procedures, full body MRI, CT Scan, mammography etc. The 24 hours Emergency Medical Services in this hospital is the best in the city and neighborhood. Both the indoor and outdoor patient care facilities are managed by well qualified and competent consultants and other staff members.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The 1 year of Post Basic Critical Care Nursing program is designed as per guide lines of INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL with the approval of Maharashtra Nursing Council.

Intake – 10 students every year –

1. GNM/B.Sc(N) RNRM graduate or equivalent
2. Possess a minimum one year clinical experience
3. Nurses from other countries must obtain an equivalence certificate from INC before admission.
4. Physical fitness

Fees- Rs.15,000/- .

No Stipend will be given to the candidates during Internship of their clinical experiences. (4 weeks x 40 hrs=160 hours)

## ELIGIBILITY

1. Only Female Candidate will be admitted.
2. The Candidate should be a Registered Nurse Midwife or equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council .
3. The minimum education requirement shall be GNM / B.Sc(N) RNRM
4. The Candidate should have undergone the Basic course in an institution recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.
5. Minimum one year of work experience in any hospitals.
6. Candidate shall be medically fit.

## FEEES

The tuition fee per year is Rs.15,000/ per year (may be revised) which must be paid at the beginning of the academic year.

No Hostel Accommodation is available .

## DURATION

- I. **DURATION** – Duration of the course is one academic year
- II. **DISTRIBUTION OF THE COURSE** –
  1. Teaching – Theory & Clinical practice - 42 weeks
  2. Internship - 4 weeks
  3. Examination (including preparation) - 2 weeks
  4. Vacation for studies - 2 weeks

## ELIGIBILITY

### Eligibility for appearing for examination –

- 75% of attendance in theory and practicals. However 100% of attendance for practical before the award of certificate is mandatory.

### Standard of Passing –

- To declare pass, candidate should obtain 50% marks in each of the theory and practical separately.
- If the candidate fails in either practical or theory paper, she has to reappear for both theory and practical
- Maximum Number of attempts per subject is three, inclusive of first attempt.
- The maximum period to complete the course successfully should not exceed 3 yrs.

## FACULTY

Qualified teachers in all discipline teach the subjects. The faculty consists of post graduate Nursing teachers, Medical faculty of Ruby Hall Clinic and External Lecturers.

### CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

The students are given clinical experience at the Ruby Hall Clinic. The students are posted in Critical Care Units. The students are also sent to the affiliated Institutions for their experience. Field trips are also organized from time to time as per requirement.
